About

Green Freight Asia (GFA) offers a **voluntary** Labelling and Certification programme, which serves as external verification of companies' commitment to sustainability. Participating GFA Members can showcase their green initiatives and gain recognition for their **progress towards sustainable freight practices**. GFA Members are evaluated based on their companies' overall corporate sustainability strategy and the targeted measures taken to improve the fuel efficiency of their road fleet vehicles. Through **annual certification**, GFA aims to build a network of environmentally responsible shippers and carriers committed to the sustainable advancement of road freight transport in the Asia-Pacific region.

GFA Label

The four rankings of the Label–Minimum, Enhanced, Strong, and Outstanding—encourage carriers to continuously improve their fuel and energy efficiency in their operations, enhancing their prospects in the carrier selection process. The Label also serves as proof of environmental compliance for shippers when contracting third-party services.

GFA Members are evaluated based on data collected from the previous year to provide **a fair** and accurate rating.

GFA certificates state the year when data is collected and the year when data is assessed. The certification is applicable for the entire calendar year from the date of certification issuance. GFA Members are encouraged to renew their certification annually.
